

## IS YOUR ORGANIZATION ACCEPTING "TOXIC" EVIDENCE?

### The End of Implicit Trust.

For decades, the foundation of audit and risk management has been evidence. You ask for a vendor invoice, a signed contract, or a voicemail from the CEO, and you assume it is real. That era is officially over.

Relying solely on your eyes is becoming a professional liability. In a blind test of audit professionals, over 60% incorrectly flagged a standard human-edited photo as AI-generated. If trained experts cannot tell the difference, traditional visual controls are obsolete against synthetic media. We have crossed a threshold where AI-generated digital counterfeits easily bypass traditional verification. The biggest threat to your organization right now is the silent contamination of the data your leadership relies on to make decisions. Technology created the counterfeit, but it requires a human workforce to catch it.

### Scott's Insight: The "Digital Nutrition Label"

We need to stop treating evidence gathering like a simple collection task and start treating it like a forensic investigation. Think of it like buying food at the grocery store. You do not just trust the packaging. You check the ingredients.

Audit evidence now requires a "digital nutrition label". Just as you read a cereal box to ensure there are no toxic ingredients, you must ensure evidence is labeled to prove where it came from, who touched it, and whether AI altered it. If the label is missing, the evidence is deemed "toxic" and should be rejected immediately. We can no longer take things at face value and must start looking for the digital fingerprints that AI leaves behind.

#### 1. DBS CEO Tan Su Shan: "If I can be replaced by AI, so can everything else"

- **The Synopsis:** When Tan Su Shan was appointed to lead Southeast Asia's largest bank, her board explicitly warned her that even her role could eventually be displaced by AI.
- **The Takeaway (Resilience):** If a CEO recognizes this level of vulnerability, your Risk Committee cannot afford to be arrogant. If top-tier leadership can be replicated or disrupted, your standard control evidence is child's play for these models. Risk ownership requires assuming evidence is synthetic until it can be explicitly proven real.

#### 2. No 'jobless growth' as AI reshapes economy: PM Wong

- **The Synopsis:** Singapore's Prime Minister structured the national 2026 budget specifically to address AI disruption, deploying heavy capital to upskill the workforce.
- **The Takeaway (Adaptability):** This is what actual foresight looks like. They are aggressively funding human literacy alongside AI infrastructure. You cannot protect an organization from next-generation synthetic threats using a workforce trained on last-generation methodologies.

### Practical Tip:

Stop accepting documentation at face value. This month, partner with your first-line owners to create a simple digital nutrition label checklist.

Require your teams to validate three specific components before trusting high-risk evidence:

1. **Origin:** Is there a verified capture point?
2. **Creator:** Can we authenticate the source using known cryptographic keys?
3. **Edits:** Are alterations logged cryptographically?

Building an infrastructure of trust means empowering your internal audit function to become penetration testers for human logic.
